



## Manual Labor









#### **Uncontaminated Disposal**

- Normally disposed of as C&D spoil
- Not considered contaminated unless it smells like petroleum or other wastes.

#### **Contaminated Disposal**

- Call DEC Spills (800) 457-7362
- Requires municipal/commercial disposal facility
- Depends on what is contaminating it
