1. Welcome and Introductions

K. Bertuch opened the meeting by welcoming attendees. Jim Conlon introduced Stephanie Guereschi Who will be elected to complete the balance of Christine Manchester's term as Treasurer through February 2020. The role and responsibilities of the Treasurer were presented. The full membership will vote to approve Stephanie as the new Treasurer at the August meeting. The full slate of officers will be up for election at the February 2020 meeting. K. Bertuch will verify the intentions of current officers to continue and solicit volunteers as needed to fill any upcoming vacant seats during the August meeting.

2. Review and Approval of CNY RPDB Quarterly Progress and Financial Reports

No questions on the progress report. CNY RPDB Rent is billed as a percentage to all open contracts and will fluctuate up and down depending on how many contracts are open. Travel and conference charges for the quarter reflect parking for the May Coalition meeting.

3. CNY RPDB Updates

K. Bertuch reported that: the fill exchange is online and user instructions have been distributed. No postings have been made to date; all 2018 mapping data has been added to the online map and access instructions have been distributed; a WQIP grant proposal was submitted on behalf of 28 MS4s under the sponsorship of the Town of DeWitt seeking \$500K for outfall mapping and some additional system data collection; a motion was made by J. Hoy and seconded by P. Legnetto to approve the purchase of four stormwater training videos for a total cost of \$2,080. With no objections, K. Bertuch will advance the purchase and reach out to other MS4 Coalitions to investigate the feasibility of establishing a training video swap program; only 8 of 30 MS4s have returned MOA signature pages. An attempt will be made to determine why MS4s are not signing the updated MOA following the August meeting. Additional time will be provided as necessary to secure full acceptance.

4. August Lunch Meeting

The meeting time has been moved up to 12:30. A short business meeting will be held prior to breaking for lunch which will be catered by the Brooklyn Pickle. An accurate head count is required but response has been slow.

6. August Meeting Agenda

The draft meeting agenda was revised to include the Treasurer vote and to reflect a change in the November meeting date from November 7th (Election Day) to November 12.
